### **Tradition 5 Checklist:**

1. Do I ever cop out by saying "I'm not a group, so this or that Tradition doesn't apply to me?"
2. Am I willing to explain firmly to a newcomer the limitations of AA help, even if they get mad at me for not giving them a loan?
3. Have I today imposed on any AA member for a special favor or consideration simply because I am a fellow alcoholic?
4. Am I willing to twelfth-step the next newcomer without regard for who or what is in it for me?
5. Do I help my group in every way I can, to fulfill our primary purpose?
6. Do I remember that AA old-timers, too, can be alcoholics who still suffer? Do I try both to help them and learn from them?
